POOL SAFETY GUIDELINES

The use of the community pools is exclusively for residents of the Ridgeview Ranch Homeowners Association and their guests.

POOL LOCATIONS: 2801 Bellerive Dr. **and** 9624 Bull Creek Dr.
POOL HOURS: 10:00 AM - 10:00 PM. Noise disturbances after this time should be reported to the police.
POOL SEASON: Opening Day of Pool: May 1 Closing Day of Pool: October 1

1. **THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.** All persons using the pool facilities do so at their own risk.
2. Residents are allowed a maximum of four (4) guests per household.
3. Children 13 years and under must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older). Adults should not swim alone.
4. Any resident has the right to remove any children from the pool area who are not accompanied by an adult.
5. **DIVING IS PROHIBITED.** This includes running dives.
6. **RUNNING IN POOL AREA IS PROHIBITED.** Running, tag games, "cannon-balling" or boisterous play of any kind is not permitted in pool area.
7. Any disorderly or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
8. **NO GLASS.** Only non-breakable containers are permitted in the pool area.
9. No climbing, sitting, standing on, or jumping from the waterfall feature at Bellerive pool.
10. No smoking in the pool areas.
11. Pets, bicycles, roller skates and skateboarding are not permitted in the pool area.
12. Radios and electronic devices, if in use, are to be kept at a level that does not disturb others in the pool area.
13. Items such as rocks, nails, marbles, coins and the like are not to be thrown into the pool.
14. Use of floating tubes, rafts and toys must not interfere with the use of the pool by others.
15. Usual and customary swimming attire is required. No cutoffs or shorts. Babies and toddlers should wear swim diapers at all times.
16. HOA is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen articles.
17. Use of lifesaving equipment in the pool area is limited to cases of emergency. These are not play items and need to be maintained in good condition and within visibility at all times.
18. Each resident and their guests should pick up after themselves, putting any trash they've generated in appropriate receptacles.
19. Chairs or chaise lounges are never to be placed in the swimming pool, for any reason.
20. **IN CASE OF EMERGENCY CALL 911.**
21. Please immediately report any defecation, vomiting, or other potential contaminants (glass, trash, etc.) to the Management Company at 469-246-3500 or after hours at 800-274-3165.
22. Entry to the pool shall be through the gates only. Climbing over the fence or gate is prohibited. The gates must be closed and locked at all times.
